Big idea: The Lord's prayer is not something that you just pray, it's a prayer that you actually live.

- **Jesus lays out a complete picture of what it looks like to live the life as a Christ follower _____.**

Matthew 6:11 - "Give us today our daily bread."

BREAD REPRESENTS:

- 1. The necessities of life - _____**

Psalms 104: 24-28 - How many are your works, O Lord! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. ²⁵ There is the sea, vast and spacious, teeming with creatures beyond number – living things both large and small. . . ²⁷ These all look to you to give them their food at the proper time. ²⁸ When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things.

2. The Word of God – _____ and Spiritual

Deuteronomy 8:3 - He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.

3. The Church – _____

1 Corinthians 10:16 - The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper] upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in drinking it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the blood of Christ (the Messiah)? The bread which we break, does it not mean [that in eating it] we participate in and share a **fellowship** (a communion) in the body of Christ? AMP

4. The Salvation we have in Christ – _____

Luke 22:19 - And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."
