Big idea: The Lord's prayer is not something that you just pray: it's a prayer that you actually live.

Matthew 6:11 - "Give us today our daily bread."

Bread represents:

- The necessities of _____ – Physical

Psalms 104: 24-25, 27-28 - How many are your works, O Lord! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures.²⁵ There is the sea, vast and spacious, teeming with creatures beyond number – living things both large and small...²⁷ These all look to you to give them their food at the proper time.

²⁸ When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things.

- The _____ of God – Emotional and Spiritual

Deuteronomy 8:3 - He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.

- The _____ – Relational

1 Corinthians 10:16 - The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper] upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in drinking it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the blood of Christ (the Messiah)? The bread which we break, does it not mean [that in eating it] we participate in and share a **fellowship** (a communion) in the body of Christ?

- The _____ we have in Christ – Spiritual

Luke 22:19 - And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

Whatever your need, physical, emotional, relational or spiritual, God says He will meet that need. "Give us this day our daily bread."

Philippians 4:19 - "God will supply **all that you ever need** from his **glorious resources** in Christ Jesus." (Ph)

Matthew 7:11 - "If you were asked by your son for bread, would you give him a stone? **How much more likely** is it that your heavenly Father will give good things to those who ask him?"

2. I _____ whatever He supplies.

"Give **us** today **our** daily **bread**."

Sharing in the Lord's Supper together.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 - For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
