TUG OF WAR Faith and Doubt February 11, 2024

*Mark 9:2-5* - After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. <sup>3</sup> His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. <sup>4</sup> And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. <sup>5</sup> Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, **it is good for us to be here...** 

In these moments, God is real, Jesus feels close, and faith is so reasonable and makes sense.

Doubt is not the opposite of faith. Actually, the opposite of faith is unbelief. Doubting is to be indecisive or ambivalent over an issue. It's to be hung up between certainties and uncertainties - up in the air over a particular issue.

*Mark 9:17* - A man in the crowd answered, "Teacher, I <u>brought</u> you my son, who is possessed by a spirit that has robbed him of speech.

### brought: krateo (krat-eh'-o); use strength, to <u>carry</u>, seize or retain.

*Mark 9:18-19* - Whenever it seizes him, it throws him to the ground. He foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth and becomes rigid. <u>I asked your disciples to drive out the</u> **spirit**, **but they could not**." <sup>19</sup> "<u>O unbelieving generation</u>," Jesus replied, "how long shall I stay with you"

*Mark 9:21-22* - Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" "From childhood," he answered. <sup>22</sup> "It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. **But if** you can do anything, take pity on us and <u>help us</u>."

# DILUTED, POLLUTED, PARTIAL, FALTERING FAITH

*Mark 9:22-24 - . . .* But if you can do anything, take pity on us and help us." <sup>23</sup>"If you can'?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for him who believes." <sup>24</sup> Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!"

exclaimed: krazo (krad'-zo); to "croak" (as a raven) or scream, to call aloud, to shriek.

unbelief: apistos (ap'-is-tos); actively disbelieving, a passively untrusting person.

This is how you increase your faith:

*Romans 10:17* - So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. NKJV

*Mark 9:24 - "I do believe*; help me overcome my unbelief!"

2) WE UPON THE FAITH WE HAVE.

James 2:26 - As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.

This one I am adding in.

#### 3) WE A COMMUNITY GROUP TO STRENGTHEN OUR FAITH

Luke 7:22 - So he replied to the messengers, "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor.

In the book The Gift of Doubt, Gary Parker says, "If faith never encounters doubt, if truth never struggles with error, if good never battles with evil, how can faith know its own power? In my own pilgrimage, if I have to choose between a faith that has stared doubt in the eye and made it blink, or a naïve faith that has never known the firing line of faith, I will choose the former every time."
