THE TEN COMMANDMENTS
Don't Do Anything
August 30, 2026

Key point of the Ten Commandments:

The Ten Commandments (rules and laws) were not given as conditions of a relationship with God, but rather as confirmation of a relationship He had already established with the nation of Israel. Rules and laws of God are not a condition of his love, but rather confirmation of his love.

- **God is saying, “I don’t want to be your law giver, I want to be your _____ and Savior.”**

Exodus 12:1-14 - The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in Egypt, ² "This month is to be for you the first month, the first month of your year. ³ Tell the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each man is to take a lamb for his family, one for each household. ⁴ If any household is too small for a whole lamb, they must share one with their nearest neighbor, having taken into account the number of people there are. You are to determine the amount of lamb needed in accordance with what each person will eat. ⁵ The animals you choose must be year-old males without defect, and you may take them from the sheep or the goats. . . . ⁷ **Then they are to take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the lambs.** ⁸ That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast. ⁹ Do not eat the meat raw or cooked in water, but roast it over the fire – head, legs and inner parts. ¹⁰ Do not leave any of it till morning; if some is left till morning, you must burn it. ¹¹ This is how you are to eat it: with your cloak tucked into your belt, your sandals on your feet and your staff in your hand. Eat it in haste; it is the LORD's Passover.

¹² "On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn – both men and animals – and I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD. ¹³ The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt. ¹⁴ "This is a day you are to commemorate; for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the LORD – a lasting ordinance.

2. God wants to be your one and only God (commandment #1) and He doesn't want us to attempt to make, build, or erect anything in His place. (Commandment #2) Don't misuse God's name. (Commandment #3)

Exodus 20:8- "**Remember** the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ...

3. Why would God include that in the top _____ and make it #4?

Exodus 20:8-9- "**Remember** the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work ...

Exodus 16:26-30- Six days you are to gather it, but on the seventh day, the Sabbath, there will not be any." ²⁷ Nevertheless, some of the people went out on the seventh day to gather it, but they found none. ²⁸ Then the LORD said to Moses, "How long will you refuse to keep my commands and my instructions? ²⁹ Bear in mind that the LORD has given you the Sabbath; that is why on the sixth day he gives you bread for two days. Everyone is to stay where he is on the seventh day; no one is to go out." ³⁰ So the people rested on the seventh day.

4. God gave them a _____ reminder to depend on Him.

Exodus 20:10 - but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.

Exodus 20:11 - For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

5. Everything we are and have comes from the source, _____ the provider.

6. The key truth to this command: Do I _____ God as my provider? That is the point of the Sabbath.
