Big idea: The Lord's prayer is not something that you just pray, it's a prayer that you actually live.

- **The only solution to serenity is to surrender. Serenity comes through surrender.**
- **This part of the prayer is not so much a prayer asking God to do something, as it is a prayer asking that we would do something.**

2. Learning to be _____.

Situations that you cannot change:

- *You can worry about it.*
- *You can resent it and get bitter about it.*
- *You can feel guilty about it.*
- *You can have self-pity about it.*
- *You can be fearful and worry about it.*

OR except it and learn to be content with it.

Philippians 4:11-13 - I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have **learned** to be **content** whatever the circumstances. ¹² I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have **learned** the **secret** of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. ¹³ **I can do everything through him who gives me strength.**
