Big Idea:

Happiness is ______. (Flesh)

"Happiness" comes from the word "happenstance," from which we get the word "circumstance." It depends on happenings.

Joy is _____. (Spirit)

Philippians 1:27 - "**WHATEVER HAPPENS**, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News of Christ!"

Essentials to being happy, no matter what:

1. See every problem from ______ point of view.

Paul's view of his circumstances:

Philippians 1:12-13 - Now I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to <u>advance the gospel</u>. ¹³ As a result, it has become clear throughout the <u>whole palace guard</u> and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ.

• Everything else in Paul's life had importance only to the degree that it affected the progress of the gospel.

When I face problems joyfully:

• It is a ______ to unbelievers.

Philippians 1:13 - As a result, it has become clear throughout the whole palace guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ.

It is _______to believers.

Philippians 1:14 - Because of my chains, most of the brothers in the Lord have been encouraged to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly.

2. Don't let _____ control my attitude.

Philippians 1:15-18 - It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill. ¹⁶ The latter do so in love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. ¹⁷ The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. ¹⁸ But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice....

Critics, Comrades, Competitors, & Conspirators:

Philippians 1:15-17 - Of course, some preach Christ because they are <u>jealous</u> <u>and quarrelsome</u>. Others preach from <u>genuine good will.</u> ¹⁶ These do so out <u>of love</u>, and they know God's given me the work of defending the gospel. ¹⁷ Others preach Christ <u>insincerely</u> from a spirit of <u>selfish ambition</u>. Others just want <u>to stir up more trouble for me</u>, and add to my pain while I am in prison." GNT

Paul's attitude:

Philippians 1:18 - "But <u>it doesn't really matter</u>! The IMPORTANT THING is that in every way, whether for right or wrong reasons, the message of Christ is being shared! SO <u>I am happy</u>, and <u>I will continue to be happy</u>!" (NCV)

Philippians 1:29-30 - "For you have been given <u>not only</u> the privilege of trusting in Christ but also <u>the privilege of suffering for him</u>. ³⁰ <u>We are in this fight</u> <u>together</u>. You have seen me <u>suffer for him</u> in the past, and you know that I am <u>still in the midst</u> of a great struggle." NLT
