1. MEN WHO _____ DEEPLY ABOUT _____.

Philippians 2:20- 21 - "He is the only one . . . who **really cares** about you. ²¹ Everyone else is **concerned only with his own affairs**, not about the cause of Christ." (GN)

Philippians 2:20 - "... they are all wrapped up in their own affairs..." (Phillips)

The world teaches men to chase success.

God calls men to shepherd people.

Real strength is seen in compassion:

- loving your family well,
- being present,
- listening,
- encouraging,
- and carrying the burdens of others.

People may forget what you achieved, but they will remember how you loved them.

2. MEN WHO _____ WHAT THEY _____.

Philippians 2:22 - "... Timothy has **proved** himself ... he has **served** with me in the work of the gospel."

Philippians 2:25-27 - (Ephroditus) "... is your messenger, whom you sent to take care of my needs ... He was **ill, and almost died**. But God had mercy on him ..."

- and faithful when life gets difficult.

James 2:17- “Faith, by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.”

4. MEN WHO _____ PURPOSE OVER _____.

Philippians 2:29-30- “Welcome him in the Lord with great joy and honor men like him,³⁰ because he almost died for the work of Christ, RISKING his life to make up for the help you could not give me.”

Courage is not the absence of fear – it is obedience in spite of fear.

Romans 12:1-2- “So then my brothers, because of God’s great mercy to us . . . Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to His service and pleasing to Him.² Don’t conform to the standard of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind.” (GN)

2 Chronicles 16:9- For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen Those whose hearts are fully committed to him.
