James 5:7- Be patient, then, brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop and how patient he is

James 5:10 - Brothers, as an example of <u>patience</u> in the face of suffering, <u>take the prophets</u> who spoke in the name of the Lord.
*Macro means: <u>long</u> *Thumos means: <u>heat</u>

A. Wait

James 5:9 - Don't grumble against each other, brothers, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

Grumble: "to groan within oneself," or "to sigh." It describes an attitude that is internal and unexpressed.
