4. VOI
1. YOU MUST BE WILLING TO LET GOD ANSWER IN HIS OWN
Luke 1:9, 11-13, 18- he was chosen by lot, according to the custom of the priesthood, to go into the temple of the Lord and burn incense ¹¹ Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing at the right side of the altar of incense ¹² When Zechariah saw him, he was startled and was gripped with fear ¹³ But the angel said to him: "Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been heard . Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to give him the name John ¹⁸ Zechariah asked the angel, "How can I be sure of this? I am an old man and my wife is well along in years." Isaiah 55:8-"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD. 9"As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.
Ephesians 3:20 - Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,
GOD ALWAYS GIVES HIS BEST TO THOSE WHO LEAVE THE CHOICE TO HIM.
3. YOU MUST BE WILLING TO LET GOD ANSWER IN HIS OWN
<u>FACT</u> : GOD OFTEN WAITS UNTIL THE SITUATION IS HUMANLY IMPOSSIBLE BEFORE HE ANSWERS.
John 11:3, 17, 21 - So the sisters sent word to Jesus, "Lord, the one you love is sick." ¹⁷ On his arrival, Jesus found that <u>Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.</u> ²¹ "Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "if you had been here, my brother would not have died.
John 11:39-40 - "But, Lord," said Martha, the sister of the dead man, "by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days." ⁴⁰ Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?"
4. BE WILLING TO LET GOD ANSWER FOR HIS OWN
Romans 1:7, 10, 15 - To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be

Romans 1:7, 10, 15 - To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints:... constantly I remember you ¹⁰ in my prayers at all times; and I pray that now at last by God's will the way may be opened for me to come to you...¹⁵ That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are at Rome.

Romans 15:20 - It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation.

Romans 15:24 - I plan to do so when I go to Spain.

Acts 28:16 - When we got to Rome, Paul was allowed to live by himself, with a soldier to guard him.

Summarize: When you pray and the request is not right, God says "No." When you pray and you're not right, God says, "Grow." When you pray and the timing is not right, God says, "Slow." When everything's in place, God says, "Go." He gives the green light and you're able to move.
