THANKSGIVING  
November 19, 2023

*Exodus 15:1, 2, 6,11,13,18* - Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the LORD: "I will sing to the LORD, for he is highly exalted. The horse and its rider he has hurled into the sea. <sup>2</sup> The LORD is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. . . . <sup>6</sup> "Your right hand, O LORD, was majestic in power. Your right hand, O LORD, shattered the enemy. . . . <sup>11</sup> "Who among the gods is like you, O LORD? Who is like you – majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders? . . . <sup>13</sup> "In your unfailing love you will lead the people you have redeemed. In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling. . . . <sup>18</sup> The LORD will reign for ever and ever." . . .

*Exodus 15:22-25* - Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea and they went into the Desert of Shur. For three days they traveled in the desert without finding water. <sup>23</sup> . . . they could not drink its water because it was bitter. <sup>24</sup> So the people **grumbled against Moses, saying, "What are we to drink?"** <sup>25</sup> Then Moses cried out to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a piece of wood. He threw it into the water, and the water became sweet.

*Exodus 16:6-7* - So Moses and Aaron said to all the Israelites, "In the evening you will know that it was the LORD who brought you out of Egypt, <sup>7</sup> and in the morning you will see the glory of the LORD, because he has heard your grumbling against him. . . . Who are we? You are not grumbling against us, **but against the LORD.**"

1. MOST BLESSINGS WE TAKE FOR \_\_\_\_\_.

2. \_\_\_\_\_ IS BIG IN DETERMINING HOW THANKFUL YOU ARE. HALF THE WORLD IS UNHAPPY BECAUSE THEY DON'T HAVE THE THINGS THAT ARE MAKING THE OTHER HALF UNHAPPY.

**3. A THANKFUL LIFE IS NOT TO GET ALL YOU WANT, BUT TO BE GRATEFUL FOR WHAT YOU \_\_\_\_\_.**

*Psalms 103:1-5* - **Praise the Lord**, O my soul; **all my inmost being**, praise his holy name. <sup>2</sup> Praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits – <sup>3</sup> who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, <sup>4</sup> who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, <sup>5</sup> who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

**4. “PRAISE THE LORD” MEANS: DELIGHT HIS HEART BY EXPRESSING LOVE AND GRATITUDE FOR ALL HE \_\_\_\_\_ AND ALL HE \_\_\_\_\_.**

**5. “ALL MY INMOST BEING” MEANS: ALL OF OUR INNER BEING (HEART, SOUL AND MIND) IS \_\_\_\_\_ ON THE LORD.**

*Matthew 22:36-39* - ... "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" <sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with **all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.**' <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

*Deuteronomy 6:4-8* - Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup> **Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.** <sup>6</sup> These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. <sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup> Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.

**6. TO THE ANCIENT HEBREWS, “HEART” REFERRED TO THE CORE OF ONE'S PERSONAL BEING. THE TERM “SOUL” IS CLOSEST TO WHAT WE WOULD CALL “EMOTION.”**

**7. A THANKFUL LIFE IS NOT ONLY TO THANK GOD BEFORE EATING, BUT TO CONTINUALLY REMEMBER \_\_\_\_\_ FAITHFULNESS.**

*Deuteronomy 8:7-13* - For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land – a land with streams and pools of water, with springs flowing in the valleys and hills; <sup>8</sup> a land with wheat and barley, vines and fig trees, pomegranates, olive oil and honey; <sup>9</sup> a land where bread will not be scarce and you will lack nothing; a land where the rocks are iron and you can dig copper out of the hills. <sup>10</sup> When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the Lord your God for the good land he has given you. <sup>11</sup> **Be careful that you do not forget the Lord your God**, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day. <sup>12</sup> **Otherwise**, when you eat and are satisfied, when you build fine houses and settle down, <sup>13</sup> and when your herds and flocks grow large and your silver and gold increase and all you have is multiplied, <sup>14</sup> then your heart will become proud and you will forget the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

## 8. DAVID REMINDS THEM WHY THEY NEED TO BE \_\_\_\_\_ WITH EVERY PART OF THEIR LIFE.

*Psalms 103:1-5* - Praise the Lord, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. <sup>2</sup> Praise the Lord, O my soul, and **forget not all his benefits** – <sup>3</sup> who **forgives all your sins** and **heals all your diseases**, <sup>4</sup> who **redeems your life from the pit** and **crowns you with love and compassion**, <sup>5</sup> who **satisfies your desires with good things** so that your youth **is renewed like the eagle's**.
