Please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet <u>I want your will to be done</u> , not mine." (NLT) Philippians 2:8-9 - And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death — even death on a cross! ⁹ Therefore God exalted

him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name \dots
