# Dating, Marriage, and Life Warning – You Might be Fighting Dirty July 14, 2024

**Big Idea:** To have emotionally healthy relationships, eliminate "dirty fighting" tactics and fight cleanly for the sake of the relationship.

Matthew 22:36-39 - "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" <sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

John 13:34-35 - "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.  $^{35}$  By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

How you <u>RESPOND</u> to conflict is what can take unresolved tension and grow it into a maturing relationship.
