-- When Paul's assessment of Jesus changed, so did his assessment of himself and everyone else.

2 Corinthians 5:17 - Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

- -- <u>New</u> means new in quality, not just in sequence; believers' "old self was crucified with Him" (Romans 6:6); they have therefore "laid aside the old self . . . and put on the new self" (Ephesians 4:22, 24; Colossians 3:9-10).
- -- The perfect tense of the verb (has come) indicates a past act with continuing results in the present. God plants new desires, loves, inclinations, and truths in the redeemed, so that they live in the midst of the old creation with a new creation perspective.

2 Corinthians 5:17 - Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

Judges 6:14-15 - The Lord turned to him and said, "Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian's hand. Am I not sending you?" ¹⁵ "But Lord," Gideon asked, "how can I save Israel? My clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my family."
