1. The pace of technology has surpassed our capacity to develop enough wisdom to handle it so there's a sense of being overwhelmed. How do we handle the new apps that our kids are going to install on their phone next week? The truth is we don't even know how to handle the current technology our family is using on their phones and tablets today.

2. <u>QUESTIONS</u> parents should ask about technology:

- A. Has this technology brought your family closer together, or pushed you apart?
- B. How does this game/phone/computer/tablet benefit your family?
- C. Can your children disengage easily from this device?
- D. Has this device changed your children's behavior, personality, or mood in any way?
- E. Has your child lost interest in any other activities or relationships since it was introduced?
- F. Does your child view usage of this device as a privilege or a right?
- G. How would your family change if you took away this device altogether?
- 3. God's goal for parents:
 - Parents, <u>YOU</u> have to <u>PREPARE</u> your kids to move <u>OUT</u> and <u>TRANSFER</u> their dependence away from you and onto God.

Deuteronomy 6:1-7- These are the commands, decrees and laws the Lord your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess, ² so <u>that you</u>, your <u>children</u> and <u>their children</u> after them may <u>fear the Lord your God</u> as long as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life. ³ Hear, O Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the Lord, the God of your fathers, promised you. ⁴ Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵ Love the Lord your God with <u>all</u> your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. ⁶ These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. ⁷ Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
