- What we worry about the most often reveals where we trust God the _____.

Matthew 6:25, 27 - "Therefore I tell you, **do not worry about your life** ...²⁷ Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?"

"Worrying doesn't empty tomorrow of its sorrow; it empties today of its strength." – Corrie ten Boom

Genesis 2:16-17 - And the Lord God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; ¹⁷ **but you must not** eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."

We have to answer these questions:

- **Did God really say? Can you trust God? Is God really trustworthy?**

Genesis 3:1 - Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "**Did God really say**, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"

Is God trustworthy?

Psalm 62:7-8 - My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge. ⁸ **Trust in him at all times**, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge.

God is trustworthy:

1. God has been faithful _____.

Exodus 13:3- And Moses said to the people, "Remember this day in which you departed from Egypt, from the house of slavery; for by a powerful hand the LORD brought you out from this place. . . ." NASB

2. God is faithful _____.

Numbers 14:9- "Only do not rebel against the LORD. And do not be afraid of the people of the land, because we will devour them. Their protection is gone, but **the LORD is with us**. Do not be afraid of them."

Matthew 1:22-23- All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: ²³ "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel"—which means, "**God with us**."

Matthew 28:18-20 - Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. **And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.**"

- It's not that every single time we get in a difficult situation, God pulls us out of the situation. It's that every single time, He enters into the situation with us.

3. God will be faithful _____.

Genesis 12:1-2- The Lord had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. ² "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.

Numbers 13:1-2 – The LORD said to Moses, ² “Send some men to explore the land of Canaan, **which I am giving to the Israelites**. From each ancestral tribe send one of its leaders.”

Revelation 21:3-5 – And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Look! God’s dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. ⁴“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death ‘or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.” ⁵He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!” Then he said, “Write this down, for these words are **trustworthy and true**.”

Isaiah 46:4 – “... I am he, I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.”

John 14:1 – “Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me.”
