B.C.: BEFORE CHRISTMAS Jeremiah: A Vision of Hope

12-19-21

Jeremiah 1:5 - "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

Jeremiah 33:14-16 - "The day will come," says the Lord, "when I will do for Israel and Judah all the good things I have promised them. ¹⁵ In those days and at that time I will raise up a righteous descendant from King David's line. He will do what is just and right throughout the land. ¹⁶ In that day Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will live in safety. And this will be its name: 'The Lord Is Our Righteousness.'" NLT

Big Idea: In Jesus, we find hope for the future that changes our present.

Luke 2:1, 4-7, 11 - In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world... ⁴ So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. ⁵ He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. ⁶ While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, ⁷ and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn... ¹¹ Today in the town of David <u>a Savior</u> has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.

Jeremiah 33:16 - And this will be its name: 'The Lord Is Our Righteousness.' NLT	Г
What does it mean that Jesus is	_ righteousness'
A righteous <i>person</i> is someone who lives completely	with God.

Romans 3:10 - As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one..."

2 Corinthians 5:21 - God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

That means...

- No matter how discouraged I might be about some areas of my life...
- No matter how defeated I might feel in areas I struggle with...
- No matter how many times I have stumbled or fallen or lost my way...

I have hope. You have hope. In Jesus, we have hope.

- Hope that declares we are accepted as God's sons and daughters.
- Hope that promises we are never alone.
- Hope that reminds us that there are always second chances.
- Hope that says no matter how dark the night, morning will come.
- Hope that is leading us to a place where there will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain.
- 2. In Jesus, we have a Savior who has rescued us from the destruction and devastation of this world and promises us a better future.
- This hope for the future can transform our present.

Mark 6:45-52- Immediately Jesus made his disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. 46 After leaving them, he went up on a mountainside to pray. 47 When evening came, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and he was alone on land. 48 He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night he went out to them, walking on the lake. He was about to pass by them, 49 but when they saw him walking on the lake, they thought he was a ghost. They cried out, 50 because they all saw him and were terrified. Immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." 51 Then he climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. They were completely amazed, 52 for they had not understood about the loaves; their hearts were hardened.
