 The book of Acts tells us the story of the first century church. It didn't begin as an institution. It began as a movement.

ekklesia (Church) actually means: an assembly or gathering.

- 1. THE <u>MAIN</u> MESSAGE. 2. THE <u>MISSION</u> EXPANDED. 3. THE <u>DEVOTION</u> OF THE PEOPLE.
 - Devoted means: To be earnest towards, to persevere, be constantly diligent, or to attend tirelessly all the exercises.

Acts 2:42-47 - They <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ <u>Selling their possessions and goods,</u> <u>they gave to anyone as he had need</u>. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with <u>glad and sincere hearts</u>, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
