Big Idea: To love the Word, learn the Word and live out the Word.

1. YOU _____ IT WITH YOUR EARS.

James 1:19-21 - "My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be **quick to listen**, slow to speak and slow to become angry, ²⁰ for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires. ²¹ Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly **accept the word planted in you**, which can save you.

Do what it says. ²³ Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror ²⁴ and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. ²⁵ But the man who **looks intently** into the perfect law that gives freedom, and **continues** to do this, **not forgetting** what he has heard, but **doing** it – he **will be blessed** in what he does.
