1 Corinthians 11:23-26 - For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in <u>remembrance of me</u>." ²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in <u>remembrance of me</u>." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

Communion: koinonia (koy-nohn-ee'-ah); **<u>participation</u>**, sharing, communion.

1 Corinthians 10:16 - Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a **<u>participation</u>** in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a **<u>participation</u>** in the body of Christ?
