Big Idea: The longer we look at distorted truth as truth, the more likely we will ______ it as a truth.

1. There's an invisible world that <u>impacts</u> our visible world every single day.

2. The Bible says that there is a distorter of truth. He distorts the truth just enough to get us in trouble, but not enough to <u>scare</u> us away. *John 8:38-44*

3. Jesus believed that the devil's ultimate agenda was the destruction of human life, and that the means by which he destroyed human life was through <u>distorting</u> the truth.

4. How much destruction can he cause by distorting truth? *Gen 3:1-6*

5. <u>Schemes</u>: Carries the idea of craftiness, cunning, and deception. The term was often used of a wild animal that cunningly stalked and then unexpectedly pounced on its prey. Satan's evil schemes are built around stealth and deception.

Ecclesiastes 2:10 - My heart took <u>delight in all my work</u>, and this was the reward for all my labor. ¹¹ Yet when I surveyed all that my hands had done and what I had toiled to achieve, everything was <u>meaningless</u>, a chasing after the wind...
