## Mountain Moving Prayer Seeking God for a Breakthrough Part 2

11-25-18

Matthew 17:20 - He replied, "Because you have so little faith. I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

*Mark 9:29* - And He told them, "This kind can come out by nothing but prayer [and fasting]." HCSB

2 Chronicles 20:1-4 - After this, the Moabites and Ammonites, together with some of the Meunites, came to fight against Jehoshaphat. <sup>2</sup> People came and told Jehoshaphat, "A vast multitude from beyond the Dead Sea and from Edom has come to fight against you; they are already in Hazazon-tamar" (that is, En-gedi). <sup>3</sup> Jehoshaphat was afraid, so he resolved to seek the Lord. So he proclaimed a fast for all Judah, <sup>4</sup> who gathered to seek the Lord. They even came from all the cities of Judah to seek Him. HCSB

## HOW?

*Philippians 4:6-8* - Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. <sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things.

## Four habits for a breakthrough:

1. Don't *WORRY* about anything.

Philippians 4:6 - Do not be anxious about anything,

*Philippians 4:6* - Don't fret or fear or have ANY anxiety... Amp

WORRY is *FOCUSING* on my fears instead of God.

How do I switch my focus? By *FASTING* and *PRAYING*.

*Romans 8:6-7* - The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; <sup>7</sup> the sinful mind is hostile to God.

Daniel 9:3 - So I <u>turned to the Lord</u> God and <u>pleaded with him in prayer and</u> <u>petition, in fasting,...</u>

Joel 1:14 - Declare a holy fast; call a sacred assembly.

## 2. Pray about *EVERYTHING*.

*Philippians 4:6* - ...but in **everything, by prayer and petition**, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

*Psalm 88:9* - "EVERY DAY Lord, <u>I lift my hands</u> to you in prayer and I call to you."

*Matthew 6:6-8* - But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. <sup>7</sup> "And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words. <sup>8</sup> Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. ESV

*Philippians 4:7* - And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:7- And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. AMP
