Jeremiah 33:3 - "Call to Me and I will answer you..."

Three of The Many Reasons God Says 'No'

CAUTION: Use these to comfort yourself, but NEVER use them with someone in pain, because you don't know why God said "No" to them.

1. God says 'no' when He has a bigger **PERSPECTIVE**.

Hebrews 4:13 - **Nothing** in all creation is **hidden** from God's sight. **Everything** is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Proverbs 2:8 - (God) **guards** the course of the just and **protects** the way of His faithful ones.

2. God says 'no' when He has a better **PLAN**.

Isaiah 55:8-9 – "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways <u>my</u> <u>ways</u>," declares the Lord. ⁹ "<u>As the heavens are higher than the earth</u>, so are <u>my ways</u> higher than your ways and <u>my thoughts</u> than your thoughts."

Hebrews 11:39-40 - These were commended for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised. 40 **God had planned SOMETHING BETTER...**

God has all of eternity to <u>FULFILL</u> His promises.

3. God says 'no' when He has a greater PURPOSE.

Psalm 57:2 - I cry out to God Most High, who fulfills his purpose for me.

1 Peter 1:7- The <u>purpose</u> of these <u>troubles</u> is to test your faith as fire tests how genuine gold is. Your faith is more precious than gold. (GW)

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 - These present troubles are quite small and won't last very long. Yet they will produce in us an immeasurably great glory that will last forever! ¹⁸ So, we don't look at the troubles we can see right now; rather, we look forward to what we have not yet seen. For the troubles we see will soon be over, but the joys to come will last forever. (NLT)

Deuteronomy 29:29 - There are some things the Lord our God has kept secret, but there are some things he has let us know. (NCV)
