## WHAT ARE THE FOUR CONDITIONS FOR ANSWERED PRAYER?

### 1. YOU MUST HAVE A \_\_\_\_\_ ATTITUDE TOWARD OTHER PEOPLE.

*Mark 11:24-25* - Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. [CONDITION].<sup>25</sup> And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."

*Matthew 5:23-24* - "Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you,<sup>24</sup> leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.

*Matthew 6:12* - Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

### 2. YOU MUST BE WILLING TO \_\_\_\_\_ THE RESULTS.

*Proverbs 21:13* - If a man shuts his ears to the cry of the poor, he too will cry out and not be answered.

*1 John 3:22-23* - ... and receive from him anything we ask, because we obey his commands and do what pleases him.<sup>23</sup> And this is his command: **to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us.**

*1 John 3:17* - If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him?

*James 4:3* - When you ask, you do not receive, **because you ask with wrong motives**, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

### 3. YOU MUST \_\_\_\_\_ THAT GOD WILL ANSWER.

*Matthew 9:29* - Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith will it be done to you" ...

*Hebrews 11:6* - And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

### 4. YOU MUST BE LIVING \_\_\_\_\_ THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST.

*John 15:5-6* - "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will **bear much fruit**; apart from me you can do nothing.<sup>6</sup> If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.

**Abide or Remain: meno (men'-o); a primary verb; to stay (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy)**

*Psalms 42:1-2* - As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, O God.<sup>2</sup> My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. **When can I go and meet with God?**

*John 15:7-8* - If you **remain** in me and my words **remain** in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.<sup>8</sup> This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

What is fruit?

\* **Godliness** *Galatians 5:22 -23*

\* **Righteous Behavior** *Philippians 1:11*

\* **Praise** *Hebrews 13:5*

\* **Sharing Christ**

*John 15:9* - "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.

\* **YOU MUST HAVE AN HONEST RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.**

*John 15:7* - If you remain in me and **my words remain in you** ( \_\_\_\_\_ ),  
**ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you** ( \_\_\_\_\_ )

### THREE QUESTIONS:

#### A. HAVE I REFUSED TO \_\_\_\_\_ **WRONG IN THE PAST?**

*Psalms 66:18* - If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened...

*1 John 1:8-9* - If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> **If we confess our sins**, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

#### B. AM I \_\_\_\_\_ **ANY OF GOD'S PRINCIPLES?**

*1 John 3:21-23* - Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God <sup>22</sup> and receive from him anything we ask, **[THAT'S THE PROMISE]** because we obey his commands and do what pleases him. <sup>23</sup> And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us.

#### C. DO I REALLY WANT GOD'S \_\_\_\_\_ **FOR MY LIFE?**

*1 John 5:14-15* - This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything **according to his will**, he hears us. <sup>15</sup> And if we know that he hears us whatever we ask we know that we have what we asked of him.
