Proverbs 12:16 - A fool shows his annoyance at once, but a <u>prudent</u> man overlooks an insult.			
Proverbs 10:12 - Hatred stirs up dissension, but <u>love covers</u> over all wrongs.			
2. Refuse to forgiveness.			
Luke 23:34 - Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."			
Colossians 3:13 - Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you			

may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
