Isaiah 51:17-20 - Awake, awake! Rise up, Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord **the cup of his wrath**, you who have drained to its dregs the goblet that makes people stagger. ¹⁸ Among all the children she bore there was none to guide her; among all the children she reared there was none to take her by the hand. ¹⁹ These double calamities have come upon you—who can comfort you?—**ruin and destruction, famine and sword**—who can console you? ²⁰ Your children have fainted; they lie at every street corner, **like antelope caught in a net**. **They are filled with the wrath of the Lord, with the rebuke of your God.**

1 Corinthians 11:23-24 - For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”

1 Corinthians 11:24-26 - and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.
