*James 1:22* - Do not <u>merely listen</u> (*This word listen means to audit*) to the word, and so <u>deceive yourselves</u>.

"Merely listen" means: \_\_\_\_\_

"Deceive yourselves" means: to reach a false conclusion by false reasoning.

*James 1:22-24* - ..., **Do what it says**. <sup>23</sup> Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror <sup>24</sup> and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.

There are two ways to look into a mirror:

*James 1:25* - But the man who <u>looks intently</u> into the perfect law that <u>gives</u> <u>freedom</u>, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing ithe will be blessed in what he does.

Questions to ask yourself:

How do I live it out? How do I apply it? How do I put it into practice? Every time I read God's Word, I should think about living it out. James is saying to just apply it into my life.
