## Three of The Many Reasons God Says 'No'

**CAUTION**: Use these to comfort yourself, but NEVER use them with someone in pain, because you don't know why God said "No" to them.

1. God says 'no' when He has a bigger \_\_\_\_\_

*Hebrews 4:13* - <u>Nothing</u> in all creation is <u>hidden</u> from God's sight. <u>Everything</u> is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

*Proverbs 2:8* - (God) **guards** the course of the just and **protects** the way of His faithful ones.

2. God says 'no' when He has a better \_\_\_\_\_

*Isaiah 55:8-9* – "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways <u>my</u> <u>ways</u>," declares the Lord. <sup>9</sup> "<u>As the heavens are higher than the earth</u>, so are <u>my ways</u> higher than your ways and <u>my thoughts</u> than your thoughts."

*Hebrews 11:39-40* - These were commended for their faith, yet none of them received what had been promised. <sup>40</sup> <u>God had planned SOMETHING</u> <u>BETTER</u>...

God has all of eternity to \_\_\_\_\_\_ His promises.

3. God says 'no' when He has a greater \_\_\_\_\_

Psalm 57:2 - I cry out to God Most High, who fulfills his purpose for me.

*1 Peter 1:7* - The **<u>purpose</u>** of these **<u>troubles</u>** is to test your faith as fire tests how genuine gold is. Your faith is more precious than gold. (GW)

*2 Corinthians 4:17-18* - These present troubles are quite small and <u>won't last</u> <u>very long</u>. Yet they <u>will produce in us an immeasurably great glory</u> that will last forever! <sup>18</sup> So, we don't look at the troubles we can see right now; rather, we look forward to what we have not yet seen. For the troubles we see will soon be over, but the joys to come will last forever. (NLT)

*Deuteronomy 29:29* - There are some things the Lord our God has kept secret, but there are some things he has let us know. (NCV)

## What Should I Do When God Says 'No'?

1. Trust that God does \_\_\_\_\_\_ in goodness and love.

Psalm 25:10 - All the ways of the Lord are loving...

*Romans 8:28* - In everything God works <u>for the good</u> of those who love Him. (ICB)

## \* I don't have to understand God's answer to know that it is motivated by love.

2. When in pain, pray what Jesus prayed when facing the \_\_\_\_\_\_.

*Mark 14:35-36* - Going a little farther, Jesus fell to the ground praying that, if possible, he might not have to suffer what was ahead of him. Jesus prayed <sup>36</sup> "<u>Abba</u>! My Father! <u>All things are possible for you! Please take this cup of suffering</u> away from me! <u>Yet I want your will</u>, not mine, to be done!"

The Right Way to Pray:

	God's power!
"Father, I know you can do anything!"	
	with passion!
"Father, please give me what I ask!"	
	God's plan!
"However, what I want most is your will!"	
Expect God to give His grace to	His answer.

*2 Corinthians 12:8-10* - (Paul) Three times I prayed to the Lord about this and asked him to take it away. <sup>9</sup> But his answer was: "<u>My grace is all you need</u>, for <u>my power is greatest when you are weak</u>." <sup>10</sup> So, I gladly boast about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power can flow through me! ... For when I am weak, then I am strong!

*Psalm 9:10* - Those <u>who know you</u>, Lord, <u>will trust you</u>! You do not abandon anyone who comes to you! (TEV)
