Malachi 1:1-2 - An oracle: The word of the Lord to Israel through Malachi. ² "I have loved you," says the Lord. "But you ask, 'How have you loved us?""

Malachi 3:1 – "See, I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the Lord Almighty.

• 400 years, nothing from God. No more prophets. No more words from the Lord.

Luke 1:11-12 - Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing at the right side of the altar of incense. ¹² When Zechariah saw him, he was startled and was gripped with fear.

Luke 1:28-32 - The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." ²⁹ Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. ³⁰ But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. ³¹ You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. ³² He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High."

Luke 3:16 - John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire."

• Shalom (shaw-lome'): rest, tranquility, wholeness, completeness.

Matthew 1:23 – "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him 'Immanuel'–which means, "God with us."

• Jesus in the cradle means that God loves us enough to be with us in this sinsoaked world.

Romans 5:8 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
