### Why do we see "peace" everywhere but don't feel peace in our hearts?

John 14:27 - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

Luke 2:14 - "Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth ..." NLT

*Isaiah 9:6* - For to us a child is born, to us a son is given ... And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace**.

Jesus doesn't just promise us His peace, but He actually peace.

sar shalom: prince of peace

- sar: the one in charge, the lord, the chief, the general
- shalom: rest, tranquility, wholeness, fullness of peace

Jesus, the Prince of Peace Gives Us ...

1.	Peace	God

*Matthew 1:22-23* - All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: <sup>23</sup> "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel"—which means, "God with us."

*2 Corinthians 5:21* - God made him **who had no sin** to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

John 3:16-17 - "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup> For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

*Romans 8:1-2* - Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup> because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.
