*Philippians 1:15-18* - It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill. The latter do so in love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice.

*Philippians 1:18* - "But <u>what does it matter?</u> The IMPORTANT THING is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this **I rejoice**. Yes, and I will **continue to rejoice**.

*Philippians 1:29-30* - "For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ <u>not only</u> to believe in him, but also to <u>suffer for him</u>, <sup>30</sup> <u>since you are going through</u> <u>the same struggle</u> you saw I had, and now hear that I <u>still have</u>."

*Philippians 1:18b-20* - Yes, and I will continue to rejoice, <sup>19</sup> for I know that through your prayers and God's provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance. <sup>20</sup> I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

*Philippians 1:21-26* - For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. <sup>22</sup> If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! <sup>23</sup> I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; <sup>24</sup> but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body. <sup>25</sup> Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, <sup>26</sup> so that through my being with you again your boasting in Christ Jesus will abound on account of me.

Lesson: Paul understood the secret of joy. It's Jesus first, others second, consider yourself third.
