Matthew 20:32 - And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you?

Matthew 20:33 - They say unto him, Lord, that our eyes may be opened.

Matthew 20:34 - So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes <u>received</u> sight, and they followed him.

John 1:11 - He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

John 1:12 - But as many as <u>received</u> him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

John 1:16 - And of his fulness have all we <u>received</u>, and grace for grace.

Acts 8:15 - Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might **receive** the Holy Ghost:

Acts 8:16 - (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)

Acts 8:17 - Then laid they their hands on them, and they <u>received</u> the Holy Ghost.

<u>received</u> – to gain, get, obtain absolutely, to receive what is given, accept, catch
