## His Stripes Bought Your Total Freedom

Deuteronomy 25:3 - Forty stripes he may give him, and not exceed: lest, if he should exceed, and beat him above these with many **stripes**, then thy brother should seem vile unto thee.

stripes – (4347) – figuratively, carnage; also wound, pestilence, plague

Proverbs 20:30 - The blueness of a wound cleanseth away evil: so do **stripes** the inward parts of the belly.

stripes – (same as 4347 above)

Isaiah 53:5 - But he was wounded and bruised for *our* sins. He was beaten that we might have peace; he was <u>lashed</u>—and we were healed! (*The Living Bible*)

Isaiah 53:5 - But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. (*New Living Translation*)

stripes - (2250) - properly, bound with stripes - from the word (2266)

(2266) – primitive root – to join, literally or figuratively; specifically, by means of spells; to fascinate, charm

Luke 12:48 - But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

stripes – plague, stripe, wound

1 Peter 2:24 - He personally carried the load of our sins in his own body when he died on the cross so that we can be finished with sin and live a good life from now on. For his wounds have healed ours! (*The Living Bible*)

1 Peter 2:24 - He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed. (*New Living Translation*)
