

GOOD MORNING

(This series is on the Goodness of God.)

(Joy comes in the morning)

Psalm 30:5

⁵For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

Genesis 1:3

³And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

(Morning Star)

The morning star is found in the Eastern sky before the sun rises.)

Revelations 22:16

¹⁶I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

(Early in the morning, worship and build a memorial to the Lord.)

Genesis 28:18

¹⁸And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it.

(Rising early in the morning, we not only worship God, but we also stand before the enemy and proclaim the promises of God. The Lord spoke to Moses to rise up early in the morning and go stand before and proclaim the word of the Lord.)

Exodus 8:20

²⁰And the Lord said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh; lo, he cometh forth to the water; and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Exodus 9:13

¹³ And the Lord said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord God of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

(Jesus would rise up early in the morning before the day, he would set himself aside alone to pray, worship, and proclaim the word of the Lord against the enemy.)

Mark 1:35

³⁵ And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.

Matthew 4:16

¹⁶ The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.

1 Corinthians 15:34

³⁴ Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.

Psalms 17:15

¹⁵ As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness.
