LESSON 9 - THE SIXTH STEP, BROTHERLY KINDNESS

<u>KINDNESS BETRAYED</u>

"DAVID EXPERIENCED"

Psalm 55:12 - Now it is not an enemy who insults me—otherwise I could bear it; it is not a foe who rises up against me—otherwise I could hide from him.

Psalm 55:13 - But it is you, a man who is my peer, my companion and good friend!

Psalm 55:14 - We used to have close fellowship; we walked with the crowd into the house of God.

1 Samuel 18:10 - The next day an evil spirit sent from God came powerfully on Saul, and he began to rave inside the palace. David was playing the lyre as usual, but Saul was holding a spear,

1 Samuel 19:10 - and Saul tried to pin David to the wall with the spear. As the spear struck the wall, David eluded Saul, ran away, and escaped that night.

"JESUS EXPERIENCED"

John 18:2 - Judas, who betrayed him, also knew the place, because Jesus often met there with his disciples.

- John 18:3 So Judas took a company of soldiers and some officials from the chief priests and the Pharisees and came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.
- John 18:4 Then Jesus, knowing everything that was about to happen to him, went out and said to them, "Who is it that you're seeking?"
- John 18:5 "Jesus of Nazareth," they answered. "I am he," Jesus told them. Judas, who betrayed him, was also standing with them.

WE NEED EACH OTHER

- 1 Corinthians 12:18 But as it is, God has arranged each one of the parts in the body just as he wanted.
- 1 Corinthians 12:19 And if they were all the same part, where would the body be?
- 1 Corinthians 12:20 As it is, there are many parts, but one body.
- 1 Corinthians 12:21 The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" Or again, the head can't say to the feet, "I don't need you!"
- 1 Corinthians 12:22 On the contrary, those parts of the body that are weaker are indispensable.
- 1 Corinthians 12:23 And those parts of the body that we consider less honorable, we clothe these with greater honor, and our unrespectable parts are treated with greater respect,

Hebrews 2:11 – For the one who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one Father. That is why Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers and sisters,

Hebrews 11:12 - saying: I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters; I will sing hymns to you in the congregation.

John 13:34 - "I give you a new command: Love one another. Just as I have loved you, you are also to love one another.

John 13:35 - By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
