Job 1:3 - His substance also was seven thousand sheep, and three thousand camels, and five hundred yoke of oxen, and five hundred she asses, and a very great household; so that this man was the greatest of all the men of the east.

Job 1:8 - And the Lord said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant **Job**, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

*Interpretation of the name "**JOB**" -*

hated; to be hostile to; to be or treat as an enemy;

Job 29:12 - Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him.

Job 29:13 - The **blessing** of him that was ready to perish came **upon** me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.

blessing – a blessing; source of blessing;

upon – UPON is a proposition: (on the grounds of; on the basis of;)

Job 29:14 - I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem.

Job 29:15 - I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.

Job 29:16 - I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.

Proverbs 19:17 - He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the Lord; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.
