The Other Level -- The Fullness Of The Blessing

Romans 15:29 - And I am sure that, when I come unto you, I shall come in the **fulness** of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

<u>fulness</u> – complete, or having reached the greatest level; the blessing without measure

At the cross, Jesus suffered without measure.

At the cross, Jesus suffered the greatest level – the **fulness** of all punishment and horror.

Hebrews 12:2 - Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Ephesians 3:8 - Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

Ephesians 3:9 - And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

Ephesians 3:10 - To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

Ephesians 3:11 - According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord.
