GOD IS YOUR GREAT REWARD

(This is the Promise of Your Harvest!)

- 1. First you must receive the seed HIS WORD SAY IT!
- 2.Then you must sow it HIS WORD SAY IT!
- And now prepare for your harvest time –
 HIS WORD SAY IT

Deuteronomy 30:19 - <u>I call heaven and earth to record this day</u> against you, that <u>I have set before you life</u> and <u>death</u>, <u>blessing</u> and <u>cursing</u>: therefore <u>choose life</u>, that <u>both thou</u> and <u>thy seed may live</u>:

Deuteronomy 29:29 - The <u>secret things belong unto the LORD</u> <u>our God</u>: but <u>those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever</u>, that we may <u>do all the words</u> of this law.

2 Corinthians 9:10 - For God, who gives seed to the farmer to plant, and later on good crops to harvest and eat, will give you more and more seed to plant and will make it grow so that you can give away more and more fruit from your harvest. (*The Living Bible*)
