- 2 King 4:8 And it fell on a day, that Elisha passed to Shunem, where was a great woman; and she constrained him to eat bread. And so it was, that as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread. (KJV)
  - 2 King 4:9 And she said unto her husband, Behold now, I perceive that this is an holy man of God, which passeth by us continually. (KJV)
  - 2 King 4:10 Let us make a little chamber, I pray thee, on the wall; and let us set for him there a bed, and a table, and a stool, and a candlestick: and it shall be, when he cometh to us, that he shall turn in thither. (KJV)
  - 2 King 4:10 Let's make a small room on the roof and put in it a bed and a table, a chair and a lamp for him. Then he can stay there whenever he comes to us." (NIV)
  - 2 King 4:11 And it fell on a day, that he came thither, and he turned into the chamber, and lay there. (KJV)
  - 2 King 4:12 And he said to Gehazi his servant, Call this Shunammite. And when he had called her, she stood before him. (KJV)
