2 Cor 1:9

GOD - (NT:2316 - theos (theh'-os); a deity, the supreme Divinity;

NT:2315 theopneustos (theh-op'-nyoo-stos); from NT:2316

divinely breathed in: KJV - given by inspiration of God.

Gen 2:7

7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a **living** soul.

LIVING - OT:2416 chay — as an adjective: (congregation, troop, company, relatives, community).

Ps 23:3

3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Acts 16:31

31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

2 Tim 3:16-17
