God's Will In Your Soul (*The Knowledge of the Holy*)

Proverbs 9:10 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

Matthew 12:18 – Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my <u>soul</u> is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.

Hebrews 10:38 – Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my <u>soul</u> shall have no pleasure in him.

<u>New Testament</u> - <u>soul</u> - "psuche" - the equivalent of the personal pronoun used for emphasis - (<u>first person</u>)

<u>Old Testament</u> – <u>soul</u> – "nephesh" – a soul; self; life; a creature; a person; an appetite; a mind; a living being; a desire; an emotion; a passion; the breathing substance or being;

a soul; the inner being of man; the man himself; a self; a person, or an individual; the activity of the mind; <u>the activity of the will</u>;

(*Vine's Old Testament Expository*) – what one is to one's self;

1 Kings 17:21 - And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the Lord, and said, O Lord my God, I pray thee, let this child's <u>soul</u> come into him again.

1 Kings 17:22 - And the Lord heard the voice of Elijah; and the <u>soul</u> of the child came into him again, and he revived.

Job 12:10 - In whose hand is the <u>soul</u> of every living thing, and the breath of all mankind.

Psalm 19:7 - The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the <u>soul</u>: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

Psalm 35:9 - And my <u>soul</u> shall be joyful in the Lord: it shall rejoice in his salvation.

Isaiah 38:17 - Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my <u>soul</u> delivered it from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back.
