

Journey Through the NEW TESTAMENT The Book of Revelation (Outline)

The Seven Visions of Revelation:

- Vision of the Lord Jesus alive among his churches giving the full assurance that he is the first and the last and He has the keys of death and Hades. (Ch. 1-3)
- 2. Vision of Jesus as the slain Lamb rightly ruling over the history and events of this world. (Ch. 4-7)
- 3. Vision of the seven angels with the seven trumpets raining terror down upon all unrepentant people, as the victorious people of God began to worship him. (Ch. 8-11)
- Vision of the seven symbolic figures representing the great conflict between good and evil resulting in victory for the righteous people of God. (Ch. 12-14)
- 5. Vision of the seven angels who came to pour the four bowls of divine wrath upon the earth. (Ch. 15-16)
- 6. Vision of the great Harlot, and the capturing and binding of Satan, to be finally cast into the Lake of Fire. (Ch. 17-19, 20)
- Vision of the completion of the historical process, with a new heaven and a new earth delivering the assurance of final victory for God's people. (Ch. 21-22)
