STARTING POINT

- Event: The fourth decree by Artaxerxes Longimanus to rebuild Jerusalem's city walls.
- Date: March 5, 444 B.C.

THE TRIUMPH

DURATION

- Calculation: 69 Sevens (equivalent to 483 prophetic years)

"Behold, your King is
coming to you... Lowly
and riding on a donkey."

Zechariah 9:9

THE TIMELINE

"Until Messiah the Prince,
there shall be seven weeks
and sixty-two weeks."

Prophecy Timeline: The 69 Sevens (483 Years)

DURATION: 69 SEVENS

483 Prophetic Years

Starting Point

March 5, 444 B.C.

Decree of Artaxerxes to rebuild
Jerusalem

End Point

March 30, A.D. 33

The Fulfillment: Messiah is Cut Off

The Conclusion of the 69th Seven

THE ENTRY

March 30, A.D. 33
Fulfilling Zechariah 9:9

ZECHARIAH 9:9

THE REJECTION

The Anointed One was "cut off" and crucified

DANIEL 9:26

THE RESULT

The kingdom could not be instituted at that time
Israel rejected Him

DANIEL 9:25-27

The Interval: The Church Age

The Gap Between the 69th and 70th Sevens



THE GAP

Christ being "cut off" after the 69 sevens created a prophetic interval

THE PURPOSE

To institute the Church, setting aside Israel for a season

THE CURRENT AGE

This interval is the present Church Age
Grace to the Gentiles

DANIEL 9:25-27

The Remaining Prophecies & Judgment

The Destruction of Jerusalem and the 70th Seven

JUDGMENT (A.D. 70)

The city and sanctuary were destroyed by Romans

Predicted on the rejecting generation

DANIEL 9:26b

THE 70TH SEVEN (7 YEARS)

- Antichrist confirms a covenant for one week
- Mid-week: Sacrifice ceases; Abomination of Desolation
- War continues until the Second Advent

MARK 13:14

Messiah's Heart & The Weeping King

The Grief of Rejection and the Desolation of Jerusalem

THE DIVINE DESIRE

Jesus longed to gather His people as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, offering protection and blessing.

"How often would I have gathered thy children together... and ye would not!"

LUKE 13:34

THE CONSEQUENCE

Because of their rejection, their "house" was left desolate until the day they recognize Him as Messiah.

"Behold, your house is left unto you desolate... Ye shall not see me, until..."

LUKE 13:35

The Weeping King: A Final Warning

The Missed Visitation and the Imminent Siege

THE SORROW OF MESSIAH

Approaching Jerusalem, Jesus wept over its blindness. Peace was available, but now hidden from their eyes because they rejected the day of their visitation.

"If thou hadst known, even thou... the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes."

LUKE 19:41-42

THE TOTAL DESTRUCTION

He prophesied a specific military siege: enemies casting a trench, compassing the city, and leveling every stone to the ground.

"...they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation."

LUKE 19:43-44
