(John 10:3-5) "The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice."

Hearing from God

(Proverbs 3:6 MSG) Listen for GOD's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track.

1. Plan a time.

(Mark 1:35) Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

2. Pause your pace and place.

(Luke 5:16) But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.

3. Pray and read the Word.

(2 timothy 3:16-17) All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

(Matthew 4:4) Man does not live by bread alone, but every Word that comes from the father.

4. Put it into writing.

(Psalm 45:1 MSG) My heart bursts its banks, spilling beauty and goodness. I pour it out in a poem to the king, shaping the river into words
