

FUTURE FILTERS

(James 4:13-17 NIV) Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

Three Question Test

(Matthew 22:34-40 NIV) Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. 'This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

1. Does this help me love God deeper?

(James 1:17 NIV) Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights

(Psalm 145:16 NIV) You open your hand, and satisfy the desires of every living thing.

Does this help me <u>love others better?</u>

(John 17:18 MSG) In the same way that you gave me a mission in the world, I give them a mission in the world.

(Acts 20:24 NCV) I don't care about my own life. The most important thing is that I complete my mission, the work that the Lord Jesus gave me—to tell people the Good News about God's grace.
