Begin with Prayer and Reading of John 20:1-18.

1. What does 1 Peter 1:3-4 teach us about how we received our salvation? Specifically what was our salvation made possible through?

2. What was ironic about Mary supposing Jesus as the gardener?

3. Using Romans 5:12-21, and 1 Cor 15 as a guide discuss as a group the concept of First Fruits and what is mean by the "First Adam" and the "Second Adam." (Who were they, why important, what did they do?)

4. Discuss what is meant by justification? Why might some struggle with the biblical concept of justification?

Break up into your Mens and Women's groups

- 1. Share among the others one main areas that you see the Lord is growing you in over the past few weeks. Secondly What is one area that you desire to see change in your life to become more like Jesus Christ?
- 2. Each person pick one person in your life that you desire the Lord to save or change, and share that with your group so you can together pray for each person that is mentioned.
- 3. Spend some time in your group praying for those who dont yet know Christ who were in service on Sunday, or who may be in church in the next few Sundays.
