WHAT IS A MISSIONAL COMMUNITY?

A missional community is a family of servant missionaries sent to make, mature, and multiply disciples of Jesus!

Acts 21:37-22:21

A powerful proclamation, but made from weakness.

- I. Choose Courage and Act with Faith
 1. Paul's experience here sure looked powerless
 2. Weakness is where the Holy Spirit does his best work
 3. The promise of power is to govern us and our actions
 - II. Use Your Story to Proclaim the Gospel.
 1. It identified himself with them
 2. It pointed to revelation
 3. It poked them about their opposition
 4. Your story is not trivial- it is miraculous
 - III. Be Obedient Where God Sends You
 1. Your past doesn't disqualify you
 2. Jesus will take you there
 3. Be faithful
1. Have you taken the time to thoughtfully work out your own story of coming to faith in Christ so that you can share it simply and clearly with others?
 2. Does your testimony honestly—but wisely and appropriately—reflect who you were before Christ redeemed you, without glorifying your past or minimizing your need for grace?
 3. When you share your story, is the gospel itself unmistakably clear—who Jesus is, what He accomplished, and why you needed Him?
 4. Are there areas of your life where you struggle to trust Christ's direction—places where your plans conflict with His calling?
 5. In what ways might Christ be positioning you right now, through your relationships and circumstances, to be a witness to someone in your life?
 6. What practical steps will help you remain close to Christ—walking with Him daily—so that your life and your witness flow from genuine fellowship with Him?
