WHAT IS A MISSIONAL COMMUNITY?

A missional community is a family of servant missionaries sent to make, mature, and multiply disciples of Jesus!

Acts 2:42-47

This passage gives us a picture of a healthy and effective church.

1. What does it mean that the church was created by the gospel?
2. What are the “apostles’ teachings” to which the church in Acts devoted themselves (v. 42)? How can you devote yourself to these same teachings?
3. How can you devote yourself to the “fellowship” (v. 42)?
4. In what ways has remaining devoted to the Apostles’ teachings and the fellowship affected your own life?
5. How might “having favor with all the people” contribute to effective gospel proclamation (v. 47)? What are some ways you can cultivate favor for the sake of the gospel?
6. How will you model these principles for those within your sphere of influence (friends, family, children, coworkers, etc.)?
