WHAT IS A MISSIONAL COMMUNITY?

A missional community is a family of servant missionaries sent to make, mature, and multiply disciples of Jesus!

Acts 20:17-27

A Faithful Disciple-Maker is Marked by Christlike Character, Courage, and Commitment.

I. A Faithful Disciple-Maker Has Character

1. Humility
2. Integrity
3. Consistency

II. A Faithful Disciple-Maker Has Courage

1. Willingness to Suffer
2. Mission Focus

III. A Faithful Disciple-Maker Shows Commitment

1. Commitment to God's People
2. Commitment to God's Truth

3. Heart: *These questions help us wrestle with what we believe.*

- b. How does it call you to repent and what does it call you to believe?
- c. How does this passage point you to the gospel?

4. Hands: *These questions help us bring truth and beliefs into our everyday realities.*

- a. How can you apply this truth to your life this week, and in what ways does this passage challenge you to live differently?
- b. How can you use this passage (or the truth within) to share the gospel or disciple others?
