WHAT IS A MISSIONAL COMMUNITY?

A missional community is a family of servant missionaries sent to make, mature, and multiply disciples of Jesus!

Acts 19:8-20

- 1. We see in this text that the fruit and effect of the gospel leads to costly repentance. These new believers burned their books of dark magic to make a clear break from their past life of sin.
 - a. What "books" do you need to burn today?
 - b. What backdoor to your past life have you left open?
 - c. What idols of the heart have you been clinging to?
- 2. What is something from the sermon that challenged you or stood out to you that you've missed before?
- 3. HEAD: These questions help us to examine what the Word shows.
 - a. Who are the people this was intended for and what is going on with them?
 - b. What do you think the main point is?
 - c. What do you see God doing, saying, or showing about himself?
 - d. What does this show us man's character?
- 4. HEART: These questions help us wrestle with what we believe.
 - a. What did you like/dislike from this passage/message?
 - b. Where did this passage address your heart?
 - c. How does it call you to repent and what does it call you to believe?
 - d. How does this passage point you to the gospel?
- 5. HANDS: These questions help us bring truth and beliefs into our everyday realities.
 - a. What is one way you can apply this truth to your life this week?
 - b. In what ways are you challenged to live differently because of this passage?
 - c. How can you use this passage (or the truth within) to share the gospel or disciple others?
