 - a. What are some "amoral" parts of American culture that can become unnecessary barriers to sharing the gospel?
 - b. Where might your personal preferences, freedoms, or opinions be getting in the way of gospel witness?
- 3. I Must Practice Doctrinal Rigidity for the Sake of the Gospel
 - a. What are some areas today where believers are pressured to compromise biblical truth?
 - b. What's one biblical conviction you need to stand firmer on at work, in your family, or in conversations with others?
- 4. I Must Be Willing to Suffer for Jesus
 - a. What might it look like for Christians in America today to suffer for obedience to Jesus?
 - b. Where might God be calling you to costly obedience right now? What step of faith do you need to take even if it's uncomfortable?
- 5. I Must Remember that Jesus Suffered for Me
 - a. How does remembering Christ's suffering change the way you view your own trials?
 - b. What's the difference between suffering for acceptance with God versus suffering from acceptance in Christ?
